

# Easy Roll and Sew Pillow Case

## Fabric requirement, for one:

$\frac{3}{4}$  yard for the body    **\*\*1 yard if making a king size**

11" x 45" strip for hem

2" x 45" strip for the trim

## Construction:

1. Lay the 11" x 45" hem piece right side up.
2. Fold and press the 2" x 45" trim strip and lay on the hem piece aligning the raw edges.
3. Lay body piece on top with the pretty side facing down.
4. Roll the bottom of the body piece until it is in the middle of the hem piece.
5. Fold the hem piece over the roll and align the raw edge with the other raw edges.  
(making a burrito)
6. Pin all layers in place beginning in the middle.
7. Sew all edges together.
8. Turn right side out!
9. Press well, pulling the hem away as you press. Front and Back.
10. Fold and trim even to 21  $\frac{1}{2}$  inches. (21" works out)
11. Sew sides and bottom with *French Seams* to finish.
12. Press as needed

### French Seam:

- Sew down the side of the pillowcase with pretty sides out. Pin at the trim piece and use  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam.
- Fold inside out and press.
- Sew again, enclosing the raw edges. Use slightly larger seam.
