

Lap Size Rail Fence Quilt

Fabric Needed:

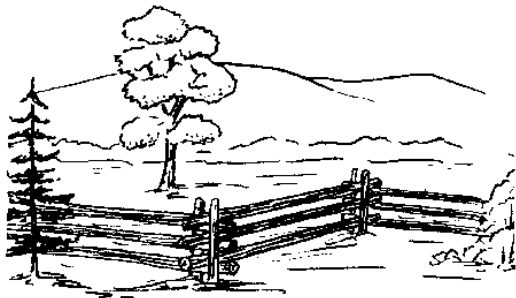
- Rails - 1 yard each of 3 fabrics.
- Inner Border** – ½ yard
- Outer Border – 1 ½ yard or (2 ¼ yards for un-pieced strips).
- Binding – ¾ yard
- Backing – 2 yds. 90" or 108"

* Yardage amounts allow for 1 extra strip for each fabric.

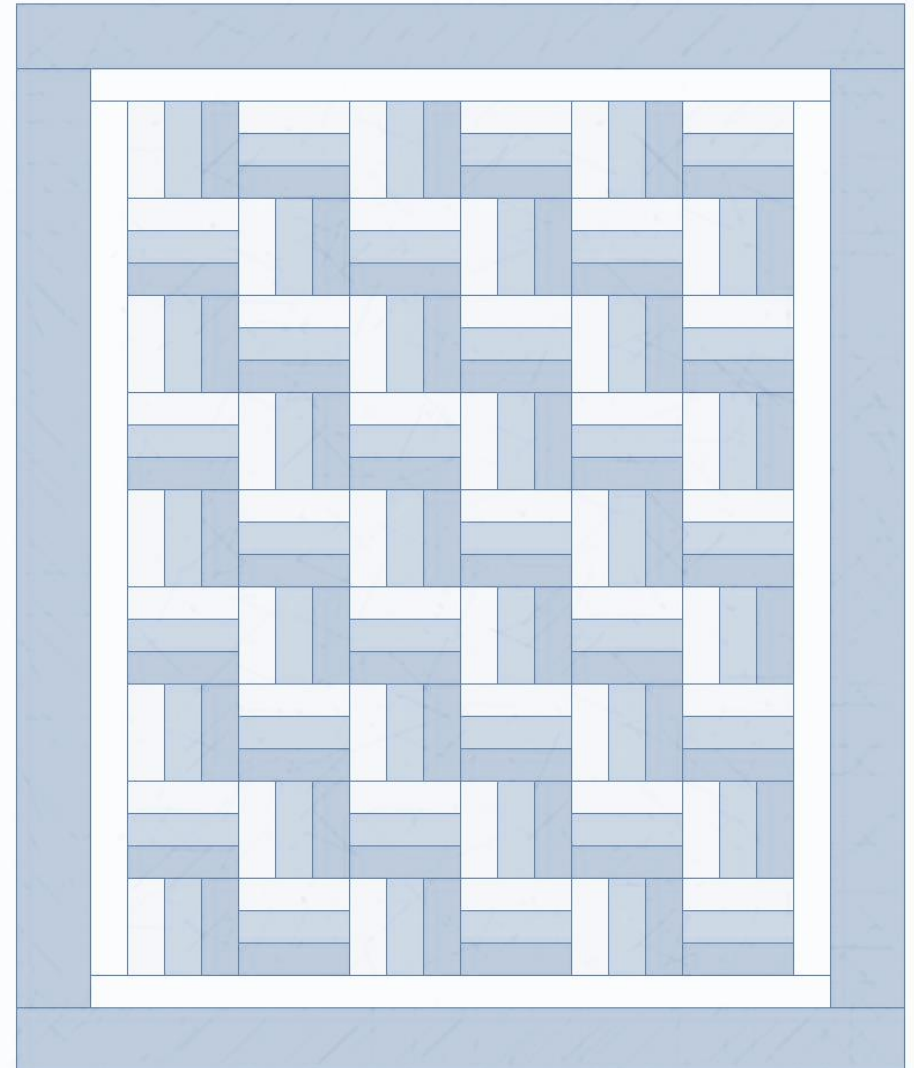
** Inner Border is not needed when you use the center rail fabric for the Outer Border.

Cutting:

- Cut 3 Rail fabrics into 11 - 3" strips.
- Cut Inner Border into 6 - 2" strips.
- Cut Outer Border into 7 - 6 ½" strips. (Or) 2 ¼ yards by 6 ½ "



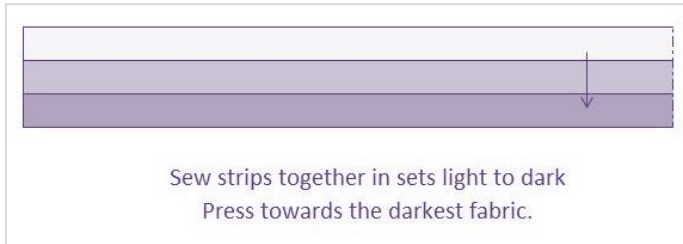
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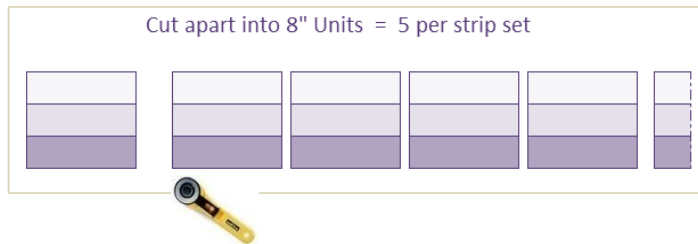

Sewing:

1. Sew "Rail" strips together into 3 color units. Arrange fabrics from dark to light. Make 11 sets. Press to the dark.

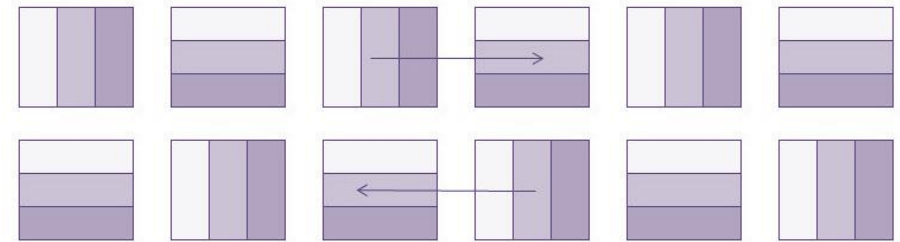


2. Cut apart into *8" units. (*note: measure width of your strip sets and cut strips to that length making a square.) You will have 5 per strip set. You need 54.

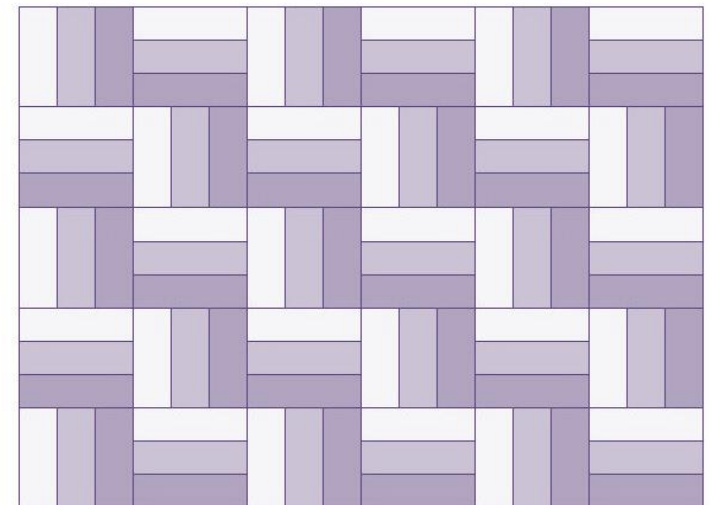
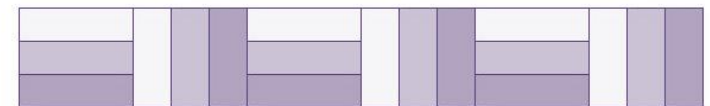
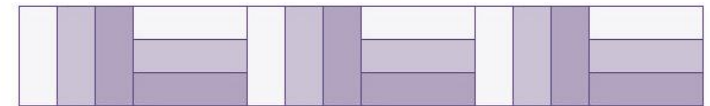


3. Lay out into rows according to the diagram and sew together row by row. Make "L's" to create a rail fence pattern.
4. Sew borders onto long sides first and then the top and bottom.

Sewing Diagram



Press Rows in alternating directions to interlock seams



6 across and 9 down
